- ~65k hits/year on front page .. 7k/year on software page alone
- Not obvious to maintain (poorly designed) and many links out of date
- Identified at Traverse City and Freising as being potentially very useful
 - BUT needed serious redesign

- Major refactor, version updating and porting in progress
- Development site: new.smallangles.org
- Base structure complete some content still needs porting
